The Project

The program envisaged the installation of 450 water points, 150 of which existed and needed rehabilitation. Due to the difficult hydrogeological conditions 1 in 3 drillings proved to be unsuccessful. At the end of the program, 313 water points were installed, 263 of which by new drillings and 50 by rehabilitation of existent water points.

Tasks performed:

- Consulting services comprised the evaluation of the rural water supply programme in the two Regions Ouaddaï and Biltine north of Abeché.
- The mission covered the final control of the physical works (well drilling, well heads, manual pumps, protection structures, latrines).
- It covered also the checking of the financial performance of the executing consultant and the overall project performance according to the regulations of the three funding institutions.
- The objective of the program was to create separate wells for drinking water with protection structures to separate them from the cattle feeding wells.
