4. Development of additional studies required (eg, feasibility studies) and other pre-requisites prior to tendering procedures
5. Formalization of the procedures for implementing and monitoring the program, including structuring in coherent phases,
6. Identification and design of technical assistance measures
7. Validation of the results of the mission with SONEDE
8. Preparation of the Final Report
